

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

1. The *Revista de la Real Academia Galega de Ciencias* publishes original research papers, revisions and notes concerned with the latest developments of Chemistry, Physic, Geology, Biology, Pharmacy, Mathematics, Technology, and Social and Economical Sciences.

2. *Manuscript submission.* The original typescript (written in Spanish, Galician or English) and an electronic version in CD should be submitted to **Sr. Secretario, Real Academia Galega de Ciencias, San Roque 2, 15704 Santiago de Compostela. España.** The CD (PDF is not an acceptable format) should be identified with the title of the work and the name of the corresponding author.

3. *Manuscript preparation.* Papers should be written in double spacing throughout in DIN-A4 paper with a margin of 2.5 cm all round. Use the automatic page numbering function to number the pages. The first page should include the title, name(s) and address(es) of the author(s) as well as the e-mail of the corresponding author. An abstract no longer than 150 words is to be provided, including a copy written in Spanish or Galician. A list of 4-5 keywords is to be provided directly below the abstract and should express the precise content of the manuscript, as they are used for indexing purposes. The following sections should be included: Introduction, Material and Methods, Results, Discussion (the Results and Discussion sections may be combined or separate), Acknowledgments, References, Tables (use the table function, not spreadsheets, to make tables), Legends of figures and Figures.

4. *Figures.* The journal only publishes figures in black and white, but they could appear in color in the printed version at the author's expense (consult prices). Color may be used without charge for the electronic edition ([www.rage.cesga.es](http://www.rage.cesga.es)) of the journal if files are supplied. The photographs should be saved in PhotoShop, .TIF or .JPG formats (in this last case, with the less compression possible). For simple line art CorelDraw (.CDR) or .EPS formats are acceptable.

5. *References.* The references should be listed in alphabetical order in the reference list and written according the following examples:

*Journal article* Murashige T, Skoog F (1962) A revised medium for rapid growth and bioassays with tobacco tissue cultures. *Physiol. Plant.*, 15:473-497.

*Book chapter* Faquar GD, Caemmerer S (1982) Modelling of photosynthetic response to environmental conditions. In Lange OL, Noble PL, Osmon CB, Ziegler H (eds.) *Encyclopedia of Plant Physiology. Physiological plant ecology II*, vol 12 B. Springer, Berlín, pp 550-587.

*Book* Scharze FW, Engels J, Mattheck C (2000) *Fungal Strategies of Wood Decay in Trees.* Springer, Berlín.

*In the text,* references should be cited by author and year: Gil (2006), Smith and Robinson (1984), Kumar et al. (2005).

6. *Proofs.* The publisher provides proofs for checking. Corrections must be restricted to typographical errors; substantial alterations will be charged to the author. Corrections should be returned to the editor within at most ten days.

7. *Reprints.* Paper reprints will be not delivered. The authors will receive a PDF file with the content of their work
